It is with profound sadness that Monticello reports the death of Foundation trustee and friend Glynn Key.

Ms. Key joined the Thomas Jefferson Foundation board of trustees on January 1, 2013. She is remembered for her quiet leadership and boundless generosity, readily giving of her time and expertise to further Monticello’s mission and programs. Among her many contributions, she was an active member of the board’s Audit and Museum & Restoration Committees, and the official representative for the Thomas Jefferson Foundation Medal in Law.

Since 2006, Ms. Key had served as general counsel to General Electric, where she oversaw multiple global development initiatives. She received both her undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Virginia, and served on its Board of Visitors from 2004-2012.

Her loss is felt deeply at Monticello, and across the many communities to which she belonged and contributed.
