

Jefferson treated his GARDEN like an EDIBLE LABORATORY. He experimented with NEW PLANTS to see what would grow BEST. He tested 20 types of lettuce. TENNIS BALL LETTUCE was a favorite.



How to MAKE: **SALAD DRESSING**  
ADAPTED FROM DINING AT MONTICELLO BY DAMON LEE FOWLER

- 1. COMBINE**
  - VINEGAR = 2x TABLESPOONS
  - PINCH OF SALT & PEPPER
- 2. WHISK**
  - gradually
  - 6-8 TABLESPOONS OF olive oil
  - SHAKE (pepper mill) TWIST (pepper mill)
  - WHISK UNTIL DISSOLVED
  - until blended
  - ADD MORE SALT & PEPPER & OLIVE OIL AS NEEDED!
- 3. ADD GREENS & Herbs**
  - (LIKE BASIL, MINT, OR MARJORAM)
  - GREENS = x 6
  - HERBS = x 1
  - enjoy!
  - Lightly toss to coat with dressing
